Type the first author's name. You type her last name first, followed by a comma, followed by her initials.

How to Cite a Book in APA Format First, let's start by looking at the standard APA format for writing a book reference. The basic structure of a book reference should list the author's last name, first initials, publication year, book title, and publisher.

The Right Way to List Book References in APA Format

Add as much as the original publication information as possible. After citing the original publication information, add the electronic publication information. This includes the title of the internet site, the date of electronic publication (if given), and the sponsoring institution or organization. Also, be sure to include the URL.

Date updated: June 19, 2020 An MLA book citation always includes the author (s), title (italicized), publisher, and publication year in the list of Works Cited. If relevant, include the names of any editors or translators, the edition, and the volume. The in-text citation gives the author's last name and a page number in parentheses.

APA Referencing Basics: In-Text Citation In-text references must be included following the use of a quote or paraphrase taken from another piece of work. In-text citations are citations within the main body of the text and refer to a direct quote or paraphrase. They correspond to a reference in the main reference list.

An APA in-text citation includes only three items: the last name (s) of the author (s), the year the source was published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. References include more information such as the name of the author (s), the year the source was published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.
