Without a doubt, Academic Writing is the most challenging section of IELTS. Faced with a blank page, you have only 60 minutes in which to write 400 words by hand. This includes 150 words describing a diagram or data, plus 250 words giving your opinion on an issue. It doesn't help that few people actually write reports or essays by hand nowadays!

IELTS Writing Tips: How to Write 150 or 250 Words

In IELTS Writing Task 2, the use of a formal writing style should be preferred for writing the essay. While writing an essay using formal language, introduce, explain, and support each point thoroughly with the help of well-crafted sentences. No short forms should be used for the sake of

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simplicity (use “do not” instead of “don’t”).
